
Ladakh is a land like no other. Bounded by two of the world's mightiest mountain ranges, the Great Himalayas and the Karakoram. It is a highaltitude desert located on the western edge of the Tibetan plateau. Its aweinspiring landscape has been modified and sculpted into its spectacular shape by wind and water over the millennia. The moon-like scenery is extraordinary, stark and barren but interspersed with isolated settlements of green oases full of swaying poplar trees, apricot orchards and cultivated farmland.






Ladakh's rich Buddhist heritage is on display during the annual monastic festivals at the numerous Gompas that dominate the area. Perched high up in the mountain ridges, these enchanting medieval monasteries, surrounded by fluttering prayer flags, are still places of active worship and hold treasure troves of superb artifacts, images and ancient frescoes. Whatever you do here you can be sure of an unforgettable, unbeatable experience in one of the most spectacular and beautiful places on earth.





At an elevation of 6120 mts, Stok Kangri, is the highest peak in the Stok Range, of the Ladakh Himalayas. Located in the Hemis National Park, it overlooks the quaint and small town of Leh on one side, and the Markha Valley on the other. Also known as Kang Lha Chen, it is considered to be a suitable 'starter expedition' for fit trekkers and amateur mountaineers. It is an excellent first Himalayan peak and does not require any experience in high altitude trekking or mountaineering.





At an elevation of 5900 mts, is Golep Kangri. It is accessed via the same base camp as for Stok Kangri. Again, this peak too is an excellent first Himalayan peak and does not require any experience in high altitude trekking or mountaineering. While climbing Stok Kangri, a prior days hike up to Golep Kangri allows climbers to acclimatize well to the high altitude environment. This not only serves purposes of acclimatization, but also offers climbers with the opportunity of summiting two peaks instead of one.





The Indus River, locally known as the Singhe Khababs (out of Lion's mouth), originates near the Kailash Mountain and the Mansarovar Lake in Western Tibet. Water levels remain high during the month June to late August, which is the best season for some fascinating white water experience. The Indus has rapids generally of I and II grades and at some places, has grade III to even grade V rapids. The popular rafting points are from Phey to Nimo and also from Upshi to Kharu or from Upshi to Nimo.
